

Communication of the return decision

The communication of the return decision is made by the General Inspectorate for Immigration or its territorial formations by sending a copy of it.

Remittance can be done by handing the copy, under signature, when the stranger is present, or by sending by mail, with acknowledgment of receipt, to the address at which the alien has stated that he lives when the stranger is not present.

If remittance is not possible, communication of the return decision is made by posting a copy of it at the headquarters of the General Inspectorate for Immigration or of its formations territorial.

It is assumed that remission is not possible in the following situations:

- a. the alien refuses to receive the copy handed or sent by mail;
- b. the alien no longer lives at the declared address;
- c. the foreigner did not disclose the address where he lives.
