

REMOVAL FROM THE TERRITORY OF ROMANIA BASED ON PUBLIC HEALTH GROUNDS

The General Inspectorate for Immigration may order, upon request of the specialised structures within the Ministry of Public Health, the removal from the territory of Romania, based on public health grounds, of the European Union citizens or their family members.

The measure of removal may be ordered only where, based on medical examinations undergone by the person concerned within at most 3 months from his/her entry on the territory of Romania, it is found the existence of a condition among those laid down by a list approved by order of the Ministry of Health, in accordance with the recommendations of the World Health Organisation.

The EU/EEA citizen or his/her family members may undergo medical examinations without paying fees, upon the recommendation of the Ministry of Public Health, only where there are serious indications that, when entering the territory of Romania, he/she was suffering from one of the conditions included in the above mentioned list. The measure of removal from the territory of Romania is enforced by the person being escorted to the border by the personnel of the General Inspectorate for Immigration.
