

Return decision enables aliens to leave the country unaccompanied, as follows:

a. within 15 days, for:

1. the alien who was found without stay permit;
2. the alien whose visa was canceled or revoked;
3. former asylum seekers for whom the asylum procedure has been finalized or abandoned;

b. within 30 days, for:

1. the alien who apply for the return decision before they are found without stay permit;
2. the alien for who the right of temporary residence has been terminated or revoked or extension of this right was denied;
3. the alien for who the right of temporary residence for developing commercial activities has been canceled or revoked or extension of this right was denied, and members of his family who have benefited from a right of residence for family reunification;
4. the alien of whom right of permanent residence stopped, if not meet conditions for extension of temporary stay right for one of the purposes provided in this emergency ordinance.

c. In duly justified cases, taking into account the specific circumstances of each case in part, such as length of legal stay, existence of children attending school and existence of other family relationships, **the time limit may be extended**, upon request, up to **30 days**.

The decision to return may be suspended if the alien:

The decision to return may be suspended at the request of the alien in the following situations:

being parent of a minor who is going to keep attending a state or private educational institution, accredited or provisionally authorized by law to complete the school year;

being married to a foreign citizen who has permission to remain on Romania's territory, granted under Government Emergency Ordinance 194/2002, republished, on aliens or by the federal courts, and marriage is not of convenience, until the date the permission to stay in Romania terminates;

being in a position of interdiction to exit Romania (is charged or convicted in a criminal case and the magistrate ordered the implementation of ban to leave the territory or locality or has been convicted by final court decision and has to serve a sentence deprived of liberty);

having a health condition that makes it impossible to apply the removal measure, until its improvement.

After suspending the measure of removal, the alien may request toleration for remaining in Romania.
